Project description: Centrum Edukacji ProHarmonia is looking for two volunteers for project IN TANDEM, 01.09.2017-30.06.2018, Kielce, Poland.

IN TANDEM the volunteer works as a duo. The volunteer either accompanies and supports child, who is a pupil of the association, in daily activities or works hand in hand with Polish partner and they together organize and conduct workshops, eg. creative activities using Lego, including WeDo and Mindstorms, art workshops, outdoor activities and intercultural education. The workshops are attended by children aged 6-12 years, at the after school clubs. Moreover volunteer are encouraged to develop own projects. IN TANDEM volunteer uses a tandem bicycle and local transport.

Volunteer profile: A volunteer should be open to cooperation and willing to act and have sufficient motivation to work with children aged 6-12. She/he should agree to participate in activities throughout the duration of the contract and the training prepared for volunteers. Some past experiences from pedagogy and youth leisure are welcomed. Being AFOL is in advantage. Ability in manual activities, handcrafts, art, multimedia, tourism would be also convenient.

Training during the project: The volunteer will receive induction and orientation on arrival and will receive appropriate role-related training. The volunteer will attend the EVS On Arrival Training and Mid-Term Evaluation.

Accommodation, food and transport arrangements: The volunteers will have a single room in a residence hall. They have a shared bathroom and a shared kitchen. At the beginning of each month the volunteers will receive pocketmoney and foodmoney. We will provide a tandem bicycle or a monthly ticket for public transport.
